Santaquin City Resolution 08-04-2013

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING WAGE RATES FOR WILDLAND EMERGENCY SERVICES RESPONSE

WHEREAS, the City of Santaquin, a fifth class city in the State of Utah, which operates the Santaquin Fire Department comprised of Fire and Emergency Medical Service (EMS) Response Apparatus and Personnel; and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2012, the Santaquin City Council, by Resolution 09-03-2012, entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Utah Division of Forestry, Fire and State Lands (Division), that would allow the Division the ability to call upon the Santaquin City Fire Department (Department) to respond to Wildland Fires when available. Furthermore, the MOU outlines the remuneration rates for equipment and personnel; and

WHEREAS, To provide incentive to the response personnel who are dedicating their time and talents to protect life and property, the Santaquin City Fire Department desires to establish special Wildland wage rates and pay schedules which will be fronted by the Department and reimbursed by the Division;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Santaquin City Council approves the following wage classifications and rates. Furthermore, that those committing their time in Wildland Fire Response will be paid during the next regularly scheduled payroll period immediately following the submission of their time sheet.

The following wage rates will apply to Santaquin City Wildland Emergency Response Personnel for all Federal, State or County Reimbursable Emergency Response when dispatched by said agency:

Rank	Reimbursement Rate
EMT Basic	\$26.00
EMT Advanced	\$27.00
Paramedic	\$29.00
Firefighter	\$21.00
Overhead	\$26.00

For normal emergency response (non-reimbursable), standard wage rates and payroll schedules apply.
