

Santaquin City Resolution 04-04-2013

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO MAINTAIN REPRESENTATION OF THE ORIGINATING FAMILIES OF THE CHIEFTAIN MUSEUM ON THE SANTAQUIN CITY MUSEUM BOARD

WHEREAS, the Santaquin City Council, by Ordinance 04-02-2013 passed on April 17, 2013, established the Santaquin City Museum Board to recommend plans to the Santaquin City Council for the protection and preservation of the Chieftain Museum and to implement those plans approved by said council; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that countless years of dedicated services by the originating members (and their families) of the Chieftain Museum has resulted in creation of this priceless historical resource for the benefit of the community; and


WHEREAS, it is further recognized that the families of the originating members of the Chieftain Museum desire to retain membership on the newly created board for the purpose of providing historical continuity to the vision, direction and operations of the Museum; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned ordinance allows for three year terms for its members who may, if appointed by the mayor with the advice and consent of the council, allow for future reappointments;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Santaquin City to pass this resolution of intent, for the consideration of future mayors and councils, to maintain board membership representation on the Santaquin City Museum Board of at least one member of the families of the originating members of the Chieftain Museum.
