**A RESOLUTION OF SANTAQUIN CITY PROCLAIMING
FEBRUARY 24, 2014 – MARCH 1, 2014 AS
“NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENT AWARENESS WEEK”
IN COOPERATION WITH
GOVERNOR HERBERT’S EDUCATION EXCELLENCE INITIATIVE &
UTAH VALLEY UNIVERSITY**

WHEREAS, In cooperation with Governor Herbert’s Education Excellence Initiative, Utah Valley University, a strategic partner of Santaquin City, is committed to provide opportunities for non-traditional students to pursue a post-secondary education; and

WHEREAS, By 2020 the Governor’s goal is that at least 66 percent of Utahans, ages 20-64, will have a post-secondary degree or certificate ensuring a well-educated citizenry and workforce that qualitatively and quantitatively meets the needs of Utah employers, which will lead to greater economic prosperity and a better quality of life for all Utahans; and


WHEREAS, Non-traditional students stop pursuing post-secondary education because of cost and full-time employment, the Comprehensive Action Plan developed by the Governor’s Education Excellence Commission encourages the State to attract more adult learners back to school, specifically devising a plan to retrain and/or enhance the education levels of adult learners in the State; and

WHEREAS, supporting Higher Education is in the best interest of Santaquin City, its’ citizens and its’ elected leaders;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Santaquin City to proclaim February 24, 2014 – March 1, 2014 as “*Non-Traditional Student Awareness Week*” in the City of Santaquin, in cooperation with Governor Herbert’s Education Excellence Initiative and Utah Valley University our a symbol of our community’s commitment to Higher Education in State of Utah.
