

Santaquin City Resolution 03-06-2014

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN ALTERNATE BOARD MEMBER TO THE UTAH VALLEY DISPATCH SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT (SSD) BOARD

WHEREAS, the City of Santaquin is a fifth class city in the State of Utah with the responsibility of providing dispatch services for its public safety personnel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santaquin joined the Utah Valley Dispatch SSD as a means of providing dispatch services to its public safety personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Utah Valley Dispatch SSD is a public safety communications center answering 9-1-1 emergency calls for police, fire and emergency medical needs throughout Utah County. The communications center provides dispatch services to nineteen cities, towns and unincorporated areas of Utah County; and

WHEREAS, to provide governance to the Utah Valley Dispatch SSD Board each community appoints a representative to participate on the board; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santaquin has historically appointed Chief Dennis L. Howard as its primary representative; and

WHEREAS, from time to time Chief Howard may have need to miss a board meeting due to illness, training, vacation or other activity representing the interests of Santaquin City which would require an alternate representative to attend during his absence; and


WHEREAS, the Utah Valley Dispatch SSD Board desires to have the appointment of an alternate representative passed by a Resolution of the Santaquin City Council;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Santaquin City to accept Mayor Hunsaker's appointment of Councilmember David Hathaway as the alternate voting board member of the Utah Valley Dispatch SSD upon Chief Howard's absence.
