

Santaquin City Resolution 05-04-2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ALLOCATION OF UTAH COUNTY PARKS GRANT FUNDING.

WHEREAS, Santaquin City is a fifth class city within the State of Utah and has the responsibility of maintaining its parks; and

WHEREAS, Utah County allocates grant funding to all of the municipalities within its jurisdiction to assist with providing permanent park amenities that can be enjoyed by all citizens; and

WHEREAS, Santaquin City anticipates funding in the amount of \$5,402.69; and

WHEREAS, Santaquin City Staff has evaluated possible uses of this year's funding which include:

- Upgrading the bathrooms at Centennial Park (i.e. new stalls, fixtures, roofing, paint, etc.)
- Replacing the chain link fencing & install cement curbing around the west ball park.
- Installing bike racks/cement pads at all parks and at the library.
- Other


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Santaquin City to approve the allocation of the Utah County Parks Grant Funding for the following project:

Upgrading restrooms @ the City Parks (new doors, new stalls, fixtures, roofing, painting)
