A RESOLUTION OF THE SANTAQUIN CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE MASTER STREET LIGHTING AGREEMENT BETWEEN SANTAQUIN CITY AND THE UTAH DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (UDOT)

WHEREAS, the City of Santaquin and UDOT entered into a Master Street Lighting Agreement in October 2013; and

WHEREAS, due to changing traffic patterns and the warrant for an additional traffic signal along US-6 Main Street at the intersection of 200 West, the City of Santaquin and UDOT desires to amend the Master Street Lighting Agreement to allow for the new signal light while maintaining the plan for future signal lights at the intersections of Center and Main Street and 500 West and Main Street in the future as traffic levels increases; and


WHEREAS, the Utah Interlocal Cooperation Act, Utah Code Ann. §11-13-1 et seq., authorizes political subdivisions of the state to enter into agreements in order to cooperate in providing services;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SANTAQUIN CITY COUNCIL THAT:


1. The Santaquin City Council approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Amendment to the Master Street Lighting Agreement between Santaquin City and UDOT, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein.
2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage

ADDENDUM #1

THIS ADDENDUM, made and entered into this 5 day of October, 20 16, by and between the **UTAH DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**, hereinafter referred to as “**UDOT**” and the **SANTAQUIN CITY**, a municipal corporation in the State of Utah, hereinafter referred to as the “**CITY**”.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, **UDOT** and the **CITY** entered into agreement #108954 on 17 June 2010 to preserve a corridor and establish a traffic signal plan and access control plan along US-6 from the west **CITY** limits to SR-198, to be in accordance with the **CITY**'s current transportation master plan and to be in accordance with **UDOT**'s current Access Management Standards and practices (UAC R930.6).

WHEREAS, this **ADDENDUM** is now written to define/update the current and future traffic signal locations within the **CITY** limits.

THIS ADDENDUM, is made to set out the terms and conditions whereby future traffic signals will potentially be installed.

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. The following are identified as existing, warranted or proposed traffic signal installations along US-6:

- 500 West (Proposed)
- 200 West (Existing)
- Center Street (Proposed)
- 400 East (Existing)
- I-15 SB Ramps (Existing)
- SR-198/Highland Drive (Existing)

2. All terms and conditions of the existing **UDOT** agreement 108954 shall remain in effect. No part of this **ADDENDUM** shall relieve the **CITY** of any responsibility or liability associated with the original agreements.

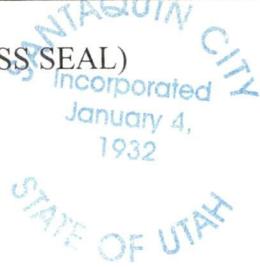
