WHEREAS Santaquin City and Payson City would like to enhance the library offerings and services provided to their residents; and



THAT:**

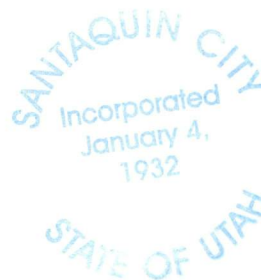
- A. The Santaquin City Council approves the attached South County Library Cooperative Agreement.

SOUTH COUNTY LIBRARY COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

January 2018

The South County Library Cooperative (SCLC) is a collaboration of the two libraries of Payson and Santaquin.

Mission Statement: The SCLC provides pleasant, equitable and continuing access to information and promotes literacy and a love of learning. We strengthen each library and our communities through leadership, cooperation, education, shared resources and services.

While each library retains autonomy over their own operations, participation in a cooperative association requires collaboration in developing certain common policies and shared decision making. Each library agrees to abide voluntarily by the following terms and conditions:

1. **PURPOSE.** Endorse the strong emphasis on resource sharing in the SCLC Mission Statement.
2. **COLLECTION.** Maintain institutional effort to support reciprocity in resource sharing, while providing continued primary support of local patron needs.
3. **REPRESENTATION.** Provide ongoing representation at membership meetings and to maintain a current awareness of policy issues, system developments, and library responsibilities. Member libraries are expected to participate in the activities of the SCLC by providing staff representation and voluntary service to various committees and task forces sponsored by the SCLC.
4. Agreement to the Bylaws and other working documents.
5. This agreement supersedes other agreements in place.
